1. KINDER GRAVES- MANNHEIMER STRASSE KAISERLAUTERN. THIS PLACE HOLD THE GRAVES OF 451 AMERICAN INFANTS WHO DIED AT BIRTH WHILE THEIR PARENTS WERE STATIONED IN GERMANY BETWEEN 1952 TO 1971. STOP BY AND HELP CLEAN OFF A FEW GRAVE STONES AND SHOW A LITTLE RESPECT FOR THISE GONE BEFORE US.
2. ARCHWAYS IN DUDELDORF- WHERE PATTON WENT THROUGH WITH HIS TANKS. REMAGEN POW CAMP SITE- ON GOETHESTRASSE JUST BEYOND REMAGON, GERMANY. THIS IS WHERE GERMAN SOLDIERS SUFFERED HARDSHIPS AT THE HANDS OF AMERICAN SOLDIERS.
3. SIEGFRIED LINE "DRAGON TEETH"- INTERSECTION OF SCHMIDHOF STRASSE AND MONSCHAUER STRASSE IN SCHMIDHOF, GERMANY. REMNANTS OF THIS WESTWALL ARE STILL VISIBLE, CONCRETE TANK OBSTACLES, 3 FEET HIGH.
4. FIRST CROSSING IN GERMANY-STOLZEMBOURG, LUXEMBOURG ON N10. A SMALL MONUMENT COMMEMORATING THE FIRST BREACH OF GERMAN TERRITORY BY SIX AMERICAN AND ONE FRENCH LIEUTENANT ON SEPTEMBER 11, 1944.
5. CATSHED WESTWALL BUNKER- FREIWILLIE FEUERWEHR, IRREL. FOLLOW SIGNS TO WESTWALLMUSEUM. JUST ONE OF HITLERS ENORMUS BUNKERS IN HIS SIEGFRIED LINE. BUILT FOR 80 MEN, DEFENDED BY TOPSIDE MACHINE GUNS AND MORE. IT GOES FOUR FLOORS BELOW AND IN WARTIME WAS SUBDIVIDED INTO MORE THAN 50 ROOMS. IT WAS 450 FEET IN LENGTH AND ALWAYS STAYED 45 DEGREES EXACTLY. IN 1945 THE SIEGFRIED LINE FELL TO THE ALLIES AND WAS NO LONGER A PART OF HITLERS SIDE.
6. TRIER
 - A. BRIDGE ON THE MOSELLE RIVER (THIS BRIDGE WAS BOMBED SEVERAL TIMES THROUGH OUT THE WARS AND REBUILT OVER AND OVER AGAIN).
 - B. OLD PART OF THE CITY (THIS PART OF THE CITY WAS BOMBED AND LOTS OF BUILDINGS RUINED AND NEEDED REBUILT).

7. NÜREMBERG TRIALS COURT ROOM/PALACE OF JUSTICE- FURTHER STRASSE 110 U/T BÄRENSCHANZ SATURDAY AND SUNDAY ONLY. WAS CRIMES TRIALS, PRESIDED OVER BY THE US, SOVIET UNION, FRANCE, GREAT BRITAIN. THE COURT ROOM STILL IS USED TODAY, SO IF YOU WASNT TO SEE IT YOU MUST WAIT UNTIL THERE IS NO HEARINGS.
8. KYLLBURG TRAIN TUNNEL- THE ARCHWAYS TO THE TUNNES FOR THE TRAIN HAVE LARGE INDENTS AND DIVETS ALL OVER THEM FROM WHERE THE GERMANS BEING TOLD TO STOP THE ALLIES FROM USING THAT RAILWAY AT ALL AND ANY COST, SHOT AND ATTEMPTED TO BRING DOWN THE TUNNELS, THEY FAILED ALL ATTEMPTS TO COLLAPSE THE TUNNELS.
9. BITBURG
 - A. KOLESHÖH CEMETERY OFF OF FRANZ-MECKER-STRASSE. PATTONS TROOPS CAME THROUGH AFTER BITBURG WAS BOMBARDED SO BAD THAT HE FOUND IT IN SUCH BAD SHAPE HE ORDERED HIS TROOPS TO SHARE THIER RATIONS WITH THE TOWNSPEOPLE. PRESIDENT REAGAN VISITED THIS CEMETERY IN 1985, IT CAUSED SUCH A CONTROVERSY BECAUSE HE LAID A WREATH AT THE MEMORIAL TO SIGNIFY THE RECONCILIATION OF AMERICA AND GERMANY, BUT SOME WERE SO UPSET BECAUSE SOME OF THE NAZI SS TROOPS WERE BURIED THERE AS WELL THAT THEY THOUGHT HE SHOULD NOT HONOR THEM.
